TASA'04 conference is being held at La Trobe University's Beechworth campus. Call for Papers

Papers and abstracts must be submitted via the On Line Paper and Abstract Submission system. Alternatives are:

Full Papers Refereed - 3000 words, 200 word abstract, full paper to be submitted by 31 July 2004

Delegates may submit a 3000 word paper for inclusion in the TASA'04 Refereed Conference Proceedings (the CD) by 31 July. 2004. Accepted papers will be allotted 20 minutes in the conference session & 10 minutes for questions.

Full Papers (General) - abstract to be submitted by 15 October 2004

Delegates may submit a 200 word abstract of a 3000 word paper by 15 October 2004. These papers will be allotted 20 minutes in the conference session & 10 minutes for questions.

Work in Progress Paper - abstract to be submitted by 15 October 2004

Delegates may submit a 200 word abstract by 15 October 2004 of a work in progress paper. These papers will be allotted 10 minutes in the conference session, plus 5 minutes for questions.
