

30 Years of Photovoice: Past, Present, and Future: A Virtual Conference October 20-22, 2022

30 years ago, Caroline Wang, Mary Ann Burris and their Chinese colleagues carried out the first-ever photovoice project, to bring the voices of Chinese village women into a regional development project in Yunnan Province. Over time photovoice use has grown exponentially, with thousands of projects taking place across the globe, with different populations and groups.

This virtual conference aims to bring photovoice practitioners together to share experience with this powerful and participatory visual method for mutual learning and positive change. Questions guiding the conference call for papers: What aspects of the photovoice method continue to inform and endure? What method innovations inform the use of photovoice today? What new directions can inform photovoice use in future?

We invite photovoice and participatory photography practitioners, activists, NGO staff, scholars, and students to submit presentation and poster abstracts under five conference tracks:

Abstract submissions: Submissions open June 1st and close July 15th. Submit your abstract via Google Forms on our conference website. On the form, you will be asked to note your name and email address, list your co-authors (if any), indicate your track of interest and preferred type of presentation (oral or poster), and provide an abstract of 500 words or less. We will confirm by email that we have received your abstract. Notifications of acceptance will be sent August 8th.
