- Foster respect for and inclusion of human diversity in all forms
- Provide support to members to ensure inclusive and equitable access to TASA activities
- Promote activities to identify, investigate and address social justice issues in Australia and internationally
- Ensure the 'Panel Pledge' to advocate for gender equality on Award panels, sub-committees and at all TASA events
